



Dairy Farm Tours

Grade Level: 2nd

Objective: To introduce students to modern day dairy farming.

Description: The Kelsay Farm Tour is designed to give students a first-hand look at a modern milking parlor, free stall barns and other dairy facilities. Students will have an opportunity to observe cows getting milked, eating, drinking, exercising and spending time in their natural environments. Students will also be exposed to dairy foods and the importance of consuming three servings of dairy every day.
